
Mission Statement







FY20 Draft Budget: Expense by Program






Discretionary expense increases, FYE20 proposed budget vs. FYE19 budget





 - Emergencies
- REDUCES BURDEN ON OPERATING BUDGET AND GENERAL ENDOWMENT
- ENCOURAGES RESPONSIBLE PLANNING

- \$400k Segregated from General Endowment
- Fundraising 2019-20

SUSTAINING FUNDING

- Annual Contribution from Buildings' Rental Income
- Investment Earnings and Interest
- Targeted Donations
- Any Future Property Sales


