





Worship in the Time of Coronavirus

According to Pew Research:

- 24% of Americans report that their Faith has grown stronger since the pandemic began.
- As of March 20th 85% of congregations were not conducting in person worship services
- Congregations with membership in the 200-500 range saw increased “attendance” of 24% in the first weeks of on-line worship

Virtual Worship at First Unitarian

- Zoom
 - Upgraded account to 500 logins
 - 150+ Logins most weeks
- Facebook
 - 50+ viewers, plus additional viewing after live worship
- Since before Easter
 - 44 requests for Zoom link
 - 25 E-News sign ups
 - Increased participation on Facebook



Communications

- Twice weekly E-news (1,506 Subscribers)
 - Monday morning for weekly programming
 - Saturday morning for information about worship includes the Order of Service
- Facebook (1,600 followers) and growing
 - Livestream of May 10th worship service
 - Reach – 816, Engagements – 389, Comments – 62

 - 70 Reviews, 4.7 average (out of 5)

First Unitarian Music Program


- Our amazing choir at almost every single Sunday morning worship service.






