



COVID-19 Worship Masking Policy (as of December 15, 2022)

The board of trustees has approved the following revised COVID protocols as recommended by the First Unitarian COVID Response Team

- 1) Beginning Sunday, December 18th, the balconies *only* will be mask optional.

- 1) Both Christmas Eve services will be fully masked including the balconies. We encourage the use of KN95 or N95 masks.

- 2) The choir will be mask optional beginning with the Christmas Eve Candlelight Service. Members of the choir who wish to remove their masks must test for COVID no earlier than The evening before the service. The choir may only remove masks while singing on the risers and must otherwise wear masks in the Sanctuary.

- 4) Unless otherwise indicated, all areas of the Sanctuary will be mask optional during worship services beginning Sunday, January 29th.

We will continue to require COVID vaccines for all people attending services in person. Our mission calls on us to "care for one another". Everyone is strongly encouraged to get a flu shot and be current with their COVID vaccines.
